- 21-22.09 Highways
- (i) Potholes, drains & road side obstacles.
New Holdings to Churchyard in Church Preen are bad and Hughley bank. Kenley Common also causing a problem. Councillor Pugh spoke to Mr Ratcliffe and he would prefer not to touch them. Clerk to email Highways about obstacles on verges and drains. The drains in question run from Bull Hollow to top of Kenley bank. The water is running down the road and has caused quite a lot of damage. – someone has put a cone on it. Problem has been caused by Airband. Councillor Wild reported to drainage people the road further down from Bull Hollow. Drains jetted from Mark Cases at Woodside Cottage all the way down to Bull Hollow. Clerk to cc Councillor Wild into email. Chairman prepared to meet with Graham Downes but would have to be on a Saturday.
- (ii) Speeding through Hughley – no speed limit on the road so need signage. Clerk to ask for signage. Same situation in Berrington. Ordered signage and PC paid for them but they are expensive. Smaller signs are around £800. Can put an advisory speed limit – could have sign which says Slow Down. Councillor Willberry keepa getting people asking him to do something. Problem speeders are from the School. Struggle to get limit reduced from 60 to 30 and this has to be done by the Police. Could ask for Slow markings on the road. Clerk to email Dave Gradwell

- (i) Peacocks in Hughley – gardeners in village have complained, eating things in garden. Do Peacocks belong to the Queen? Person who bred them has now left the village. Very little Parish Council can do.
- (ii) School Room Repairs, Kenley: Councillor Wild suggested applying for a grant. Grant application form to be completed by Simon Martin. Previously owned by Raby Estate but given to the Church as it was a Church of England School. As long as Parish use the room they will keep it otherwise it will be sold. Discussed and it was felt that the Parish Council should give a donation although did agree that the Church should be paying the majority of the costs. Need to raise money through fund raising when possible. One off payment by Parish Council and not ongoing donations.
